#### **REQUEST FOR QUOTATION AMENDMENT NO. 003**

Request for Quotation Amendment no. 003 is raised to answer a question regarding the warranty.

#### **Question 6**

In regards to the Advanced Replacement Warranty, and the contractual requirement to deliver a replacement webcam within 48 hours, would you be able to add a new line to the price sheet, essentially to add an extra batch of 50-100 webcams to this contract, and allow the reseller to purchase and store these webcams, for the specific purpose of fulfilling the ARW in a timely manner?

Another suggestion would be that a clause be added, specifically to that effect, which would allow us to negotiate the buyback of these webcams, at the expense of the CRA, at the end of the contract. We have seen similar clauses being included to public bid tenders, in recent months, which we feel would be fair to both parties.

#### Answer 6

The Crown will not accept the recommended changes. If a bidder needs to keep inventory to meet and fulfill the advanced replacement warranty requirement, then the bidder should factor this into their pricing.

#### **Modification 7**

On page 1, at "Closing Date and Time",

Delete: February 5th, 2021 at 2:00PM

Replace with: February 5th, 2021 at 4:00PM
