Question 1

514 cables to connect the computers to the KVM and then another 514 cable to connect the KVM to the monitors. So this is what would be needed for the Firm Deliverables? The Client specific options and the SSC ITPRO options would need to be adjusted as well since at this time, just one cable is requested.

Answer 1

The client requires 514 cable sets. Each cable set must be comprised of 1 cable to connect the KVM to the computer, and 1 cable to connect to CAC device.
