1. This Amendment 002 is raised to:

- a. extend the closing date of this solicitation from 02:00 pm on 01 March 2021 to 02:00 pm on 10 March 2021 Eastern Standard Time;
- b. answer bidders' questions; and
- c. provide an updated Annex "A" – Specifications.

2. The following are answers to bidders' questions:

Q2. What will the van be transporting?

A2. We use the truck to move equipment on wheels such as moving boxes, totes (bins), computer carts, filing cabinets, office panel dividers, desks, skids of paper and much more.

Q3. What is the weight of the products to be transported?

A3. The total weight to load would be around 5000lbs.

Q4. Can the height of the van body be reduced to 84"?

A4. No, the height of the body must be able to accommodate a cabinet with a height of 84" standing upright.

Q5. Can the GVWR (Gross Vehicle Weight rating) be reduced to 14500lbs?

A5. Yes.

Q6. Can the length of the van body be reduced to 18 feet?

A6. Yes.

Q7. A 2500lbs capacity tuck away tailgate is almost overkill on a small unit like this. What is the weight of the individual items that they will be lifting? Possibly a lighter tailgate of 1500lbs capacity would suffice.

A7. A 1500lbs tuck away tailgate would be too small for our needs. We lift skids of papers that average between 910 and 960kgs. A 2200lbs aluminum version would be acceptable.

Q8. The van body floor height on a truck of this size is about 42". To raise it to 48" requires a much heavier sub frame which works against the 4500KG maximum weight requirement. I do not understand the 33" rear ground clearance statement of item 41. What we need to know is what is the desired floor height of the unladed vehicle?

A8. The truck ground clearance can be from 33" to 48". Usually building docks have a leveling ramp to accommodate different vehicle floor heights. We do have a leveling ramp and it will only level to a minimum of 33", that being the reason of needing the truck to be at a minimum of 33" ground clearance.

3. An updated Annex "A" – Specifications is provided to include the changes made as a result of the bidders' questions. All references, throughout the solicitation, to "Annex A – Specifications" must now read "Annex A – Specifications (Revision 1).
