Questions & Answers #3

- **Q8.** Paragraph 1.9 (iii) are table of content pages included in the 10-page limit? **A8.** Yes.
- **Q9.** Paragraph 1.9 (iii) are brochures included in the 10-page limit? **A9.** Yes.
- **Q10.** Paragraph 6.1 if submitting a proposal from a Joint Venture is it acceptable to provide project references from each of joint venture's parent companies?
- **A10.** No.
- **Q11.** Paragraph 1.8 are appendices A, B & C included in the 10-page limit? **A11.** No.
- **Q12.** Paragraph 1.3 Would it be acceptable to provide past performance references that comply with equivalent or greater standards as a means of demonstrating capability to undertake the 'Design Build' project with the specified standards. For example, we have previously designed, manufactured, and delivered ballistic and forced-entry rated modular buildings to the Canadian Government which are rated to US Department of State SD-STD-01.01 Revision G which provides for 60-minutes forced entry rating, the maximum level within LPS 1175 is only 20-minutes. I would suggest this adequately demonstrates capability to undertake a 'design-build' project to any forced-entry standard, particularly given that the ratings provided are mainly associated with third party proprietary components (windows, ballistic steel etc..) and (as) the modular builder we need to be capability (*sic*) of integrating these components.
- A12. In Appendix B, we will accept Standards that are the same or better than those listed in i, ii and iii. However, the Respondent must adequately demonstrate how their proposed standard(s) is (are) better than then ones listed in the RQ.
