3.1.2 Consultant Team Identification

The Proponent (~~the landscape architect firm or the joint venture~~) should submit a maximum of **three (3) projects** completed during the **ten (10) years** prior to the closing date of the Request for Proposal. These projects should **focus on landscape architecture and** demonstrate the collaboration between the landscape architecture discipline and engineering disciplines in the **restoration / planning of public places**. The total cost (design/site supervision + construction) for each project submitted **should ~~must~~ be equal to or higher than 3,000,000.00\$** (taxes extra). Only the first three (3) projects submitted in order will be reviewed, and all the rest will not receive consideration as if they had not been submitted.
