**Questions and Answers:**

**Question 1:** I am wondering if you could lend some clarification as to the level of involvement that should be anticipated for the Fish Habitat Specialist.

We are having difficulty with costing this as the time allowance for this individual is dependent on many factors which will only become known as the design and construction approach becomes better defined. Obviously, we could make the safest assumption and allow for this person to be on site full time throughout the entire salmon migration period, but this would represent a significant cost. If, by contrast, another firm assumed only 100 total hours for this person, their cost for that role could be a fraction of our cost. That one item could very negatively affect our cost ranking, or in the worst case scenario, even cause our proposal to receive no further consideration.

In light of the fact that this level of effort is simply impossible to define accurately at present, may I suggest that PWGSC make an allowance of hours for this individual similar to that made for the Resident Site Inspector. Actual hours will vary, of course, but at least this would give all consultants an equal footing in costing this rather significant item.

**Answer 1:** The consultant will engage a person or firm with specialist expertise in fish habitat for advice and guidance for the duration of the project. The specialist shall have experience in a minimum of 3 projects of similar scope, and their qualifications shall be acceptable to the Departmental Representative. The specialist shall work in consultation with the fish habitat specialists at DFO. The intent is that the Consultant's Fish Habitat Specialist will:

- 1) Provide expertise input on the design and habitat within the fishway, to ensure efficient safe passage.
- 2) Develop a fish relocation plan in conjunction with and overseen by DFO Fish Habitat.
- 3) Review the implementation of the fish relocation plan throughout construction and provide adjustments as necessary to ensure effective fish passage. It is not the intent to have the specialist on site for the full migration period. For bidding purposes, assume the Fish Specialist makes eight (8) site visits and attends eight (8) teleconference meetings during RS6 services.
