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Addendum n° 002

Addendum No. 002 is raised to make the following changes:

A. The following questions have been received, and DFATD hereby answers as follows:

Question 1:

Regarding M3, there's a requirement for a pedagogical advisor to "have a minimum of three (3) years of experience in training groups of students with similar learning levels". Are you referring to experience in teaching or in supervising teachers and programs?

Response 1:

M3 is modified as follows:

The pedagogical advisor must have a minimum of three (3) years of experience in training organizing groups of students with similar learning levels.

Question 2:

With respect to R9 and R10, the Canada School of Public Service stopped offering training to French and English teachers as of early 2016. Additionally, CSPS offered this training only to those instructors who taught groups or individuals under the responsibility of the Quality Assurance – Language Training section of the Learning Programs Branch. The training was available exclusively to a few schools on the PSPC Standing Offer.

Given the fact that CSPS has withdrawn from supporting language training and that this particular type of teacher training session has not been available for the last five years, would you consider removing R9 and R10 from your list of rated criteria? Instead, you could require a provider to deliver mandatory PFL2 training to all teachers teaching on your program as part of your SOW.

By asking for a training certificate associated with a standing offer, which ended years ago, DFATD is excluding from competition all those qualified and capable teachers who during the mentioned period did not work for a small number of schools that were on the PSPC/CSPS Standing Offer.

Response 2:

DFATD recognizes the CSPS PFL2 A, B and C training certificates as important assets for the proposed teachers. Therefore, criteria R9 and R10 will remain as part of the RFSO. However, in order to foster competition, the scoring scales for both R9 and R10 are modified with new point allocations as shown in the new evaluation criteria below.

In order to reflect all the changes in the RFSO, **ATTACHMENT 1 to PART 4, TECHNICAL CRITERIA** is deleted entirely and replaced with the following:
