Amendment 001 is raised to answer bidder questions:

Q1: Can bidders just state "yes" in the technical evaluation table (Annex "A1") to demonstrate compliance?

A1: No, bidders must provide proof of compliance either with supporting documentation or with written narratives that demonstrate they meet each technical evaluation criteria.

Internet links provided in bid will not be accessed or reviewed, only information submitted with the bid will be used for evaluation.

Q2: Do you have to meet all the specifications in Annex "A" as well as demonstrating compliance with the mandatory technical evaluation criteria in Annex "A1"?

A2: Yes, while bidders only have to demonstrate compliance in their bid with the criteria in Annex "A1", the product provided must meet all the criteria in Annex "A".

If upon delivery, it is determined that the goods do not meet all the requirements identified in Annex "A", the goods will not be accepted and the contract may be terminated.

Q3: If my off-the-shelf garment doesn't meet all the requirements in Annex "A", can this be custom made?

A3: Yes, Whether you propose off-the-shelf **OR** custom made coveralls and overalls, they must meet all the criteria in Annex "A" and the bidder must demonstrate compliance with the evaluation criteria listed in Annex "A1" in their bid.

If there is a single criteria that you do not demonstrate compliance with, your bid will be found to be non-compliant.

Q4: Canadian content seems to apply to this requirement, can we submit a bid with an offshore garment if no Canadian made garment can be found? Would we be considered compliant if all material specifications are met?

A4: Anyone is permitted to submit a bid, regardless of whether or not they can certify they are Canadian goods as per the definition in A3050T.

This requirement is conditionally limited to Canadian Content which means, as per section 4.1 (c), if there are two (2) or more bids with a valid Canadian content certification only those bids will be eligible to be awarded a contract.

Please refer to section 4.1 (c) for further details on Evaluation Procedures and Canadian content.

Q5: Is it mandatory to submit Canadian Content Certification with the bid?

A5: Yes. As per section 5.1.2.1 this requirement is subject to a preference for Canadian Content:

If your goods meet the definition of "Canadian goods", as defined in clause A3050T you must certify this by placing a check mark in the parentheses.
