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SOLICITATION AMENDMENT 003

This Solicitation Amendment is issued to provide Questions and Answers 7 through 17 regarding the RFI W6369-210257/A.

TRACKING LOG OF INDUSTRY QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS PROVIDED TO DATE:

Q#	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
7	What is the range of surgical procedures performed by DND surgeons? Are there operating rooms or are surgeries performed in the community? Does DND perform procedures that would be considered day surgery?	DND does not have its own hospitals nor operating rooms, except in the case of deployed operations where, depending on the operation, the CAF may be called upon to staff their own or a host nation's operating room. Domestically, all CAF uniformed surgeons (orthopedic and general surgeons) are embedded in civilian hospitals within the community and treat both civilian and CAF patients. DND clinicians do not perform day surgery procedures but may do minor procedures in the clinic such as laceration suturing and skin lesion removal.
8	Historically, how many visits per year per member?	Approximately 3 visits per year.
9	Are there gaps with the current version of the dental solutions?	Yes. Please refer to Annex D to the RFI. The following preliminary detailed requirements all address gaps in the current version of the dental solutions: 2.7.1 through 2.7.3; the latter portion of 2.7.4 "... ability to attach...", 2.7.5, 2.7.6 (currently DND only has a standalone 2D digital radiology capability), and 2.7.7 through 2.7.10.
10	What protocols are used for data exchange with NATO partners today?	Currently, data exchange is done through telephone, facsimile, and Microsoft™ Excel™ spreadsheets. Future capabilities envision the use of HL7 and FHIR protocols as currently being discussed with other NATO nations.
11	What is the structure of the team currently that supports the installed solutions – refer to question 5.a.vi page 21?	DND uses a multiple-layer structure for in-service support of the current installed solutions. A national help desk, providing frontline support specific to CFHIS, is located in Ottawa. Minor enhancements and maintenance (including fixes and software release management) of the installed solution are analyzed by a DND IT support team who work with either the solution vendor directly or through a contracted third-party system integration company to authorize and effect any changes.

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12	What tools for analytics does DND have in place today?	Depending on the application, DND uses a mix of InterSystems IRIS for Health™ (for descriptive analytics), SAS/STAT™ statistical analysis software (for epidemiological studies), and Microsoft™ Excel™.
13	What PACS vendor(s) are installed?	Agfa™.
14	Is any ordering or administration of treatments for oncology cases to be done in the CFHIS?	No. All oncology cases are managed by attending physicians within civilian community hospitals.
15	Does DND perform lab tests or is all lab work outsourced?	Approximately half of DND's 32 clinics incorporate their own lab equipment for basic bloodwork and urinalysis and feed results data directly into the Purkinje™ EMR through SoftLab™. The remainder of the clinics rely on outsourced labs (private and public) and receive the results as scanned documents. All clinics outsource more involved bloodwork and other tests such as for genetic testing, pathology, sexually-transmitted infection testing, etc.
16	Does DND perform diagnostic imaging procedures in house?	Some of DND's clinics have in-house diagnostic imaging capability using digital X-ray. Two clinics (though this may change) have the ability to do computed tomography (CT) in-house. Two other clinics have the ability to do ultrasonography.
17	With respect to the Pharmacy solution, is there an expectation or requirement that claims be adjudicated?	No.
