**ANNEX A  
REQUIREMENT and BASIS OF PAYMENT**

1. Category Selection

**Combined Categories Rule:**

For reasons of compatibility, the following categories will be combined for evaluation and contract award purposes:

The rule only applies to the categories below that are checked. The unchecked categories will be evaluated separately and may be awarded to multiple suppliers;

**\* Exception: when using the Cat 1, 2, 5 combined categories rule, IU's may calculate the percentage of NSA product allowed (as defined in their solicitation document) against the total quantity of the combined categories.**

**Design Upgrade Rule:**

The IU may exercise an option to upgrade products up to 20% of each Category product total before Applicable Taxes after contract award.

The Design Upgrade amount is used at the discretion of the Project Authority (PA) **prior to the manufacturing/ordering of the products**, the PA will provide the Contractor with a written notice of Canada's Design Upgrade choices for each of the product(s) to be upgraded. The Contractor will provide the pricing of the upgraded product(s) to a maximum of 20% of each Category Contract Price of Table 8. The Contracting Authority will issue an amendment to the contract with the Design Upgrades and pricing.

The Supplier certifies that all the Design Upgraded products offered will conform to all specifications and meet the testing requirements detailed in the Specifications of the Supply Arrangement.

Design Upgrade: is the process of replacing a product with a more innovative or enhanced version of the same product.

**NSA:**

NSA products can be incorporated in the RFB and must not exceed 30% of the firm **quantity** by category. NSA items must be added to the category that is most closely related and must be generic.

The requirement includes the following category (ies) of work:

a. Category 1 – Interconnecting Panels and Freestanding Systems





**WORKSTATION (WS-01) (3.4m<sup>2</sup>) FURNITURE LAYOUT**



**Workstation (WS-02) Layout – Floor Plan**






**Touchdown (WS-03) Layout – Floor Plan**

**ANNEX D**  
**Additional Specifications, Certifications**

**1. Specifications for CAT1, Non SA items – Freestanding Power Beam Panels:**

- .1 Description
  - .1 A separate, freestanding, UL Certified power and data distribution beam panels system.
  - .4 The total height of a *base height* panel must not exceed 762 mm (30 in.) high.
  - .5 The vertical post between and at the end of beams shall have 4 access points (one on each side of square post leg) to allow the system to be arranged in a straight line, L-shape, T shape or X shape configuration with a single universal jumper cable connecting the electrical system from beam to beam.
- .2 Dimensions
  - .1 Overall panel height, including any panel mounted component, must be within the range 25" to 30"
  - .2 All panel heights must conform to the following:
    - 1. *Base height* must be within the range of 609mm (25in.) to 762mm (30 in.) inclusive.
  - .3 Panel width must be 1219 mm (48 in.), and 1828 mm (72in)
  - .4 Panel must allow for a minimum of 152mm (6") and a maximum of 203mm (8") clearance between the finished floor and bottom of panel.
  - .5 Maximum panel thickness must not exceed 101 mm (4 in.).
- .3 Finishes
  - .1 Base panels must be offered in metal.
  - .2 Pricing on panel fabric must include Grade 2 finishes
- .4 Power and Data
  - .1 Panel heights must provide *face mounted power data modules*. The duplex power outlets and voice and data outlets must be offered at predetermined locations when specified.
  - .2 Power and voice/data outlets must be offered *below the work surface*.
  - .3 Cable Pathway:
    - .1 All powered, non-powered panels and posts must have concealed cable pathways to accommodate the electrical, voice and data cables.
    - .2 The cable pathway must provide sufficient space to allow for a minimum bend radius of 76mm (3 in.) for the installation of communication cables both horizontally and vertically.
    - .3 The cable pathway must house a modular and configurable 8 wire electrical system featuring from 1 to 4 circuits and can accommodate laying in phone/data cabling.

- .4 Cable pathways located at the base must have knockouts to receive back-to-back electrical outlets.
  - .5 Cable pathway covers must open and close firmly without the use of proprietary tools.
  - .6 Communication and electrical cabling may be placed in the same cable pathway as long as metal separation is provided.
  - .7 Non-powered cable pathways must provide field conversion to powered cable pathways without requiring the workstation to be dismantled.
  - .8 Unused knockouts/access points, which are visible, must be covered to prevent unsightly holes.
  - .9 Vertical wire management system must conceal wires running from the floor, wall, or ceiling feed to the cable pathway.
- .4 Electrical Wiring System:
- .1 The electrical wiring system must be made of components which are *modular* and provide power at predetermined locations. When electrical wiring alterations or disassembly are required, the workstation must not be dismantled.
  - .2 The system must provide for ceiling access, floor access, and power from the wall. Ceiling access top feeds must accommodate a ceiling height of a minimum of 3048 mm (10 ft.).
  - .3 The electrical system must provide electrical distributing service to nine (9) workstations from one central feed point.
  - .4 The electrical system must provide as a minimum, a seven (7) wire, three (3)-circuit per feed capability.

The Supplier must not, without obtaining the prior written consent of the SAA, dispose of any such records or documentation until the expiration of the Contract or the expiry date of the Warranty, whichever is later. All such records and documentation must at all times during the retention period be open to audit, inspection and examination by the representatives of Canada, who may make copies and take extracts.

In addition, the Supplier must provide representatives of the SAA access to all locations where any part of the Work is being performed at any time during working hours. Representatives of the SAA may examine and test the Work as they see fit. The Supplier must provide all assistance and access to facilities, test pieces, samples and documentation that the representatives of the SAA may reasonably require for the carrying out of the inspection, which may also include the submission of test reporting documentation as listed in Annex A and D. The Supplier must forward such test pieces, samples and/or documentation that may also include letters of certification from the laboratories to such person or location as the representatives of the SAA specifies.
