

Coming up – New Tendering Service

- A new Government Electronic Tendering Service (GETS) is scheduled to launch on CanadaBuys this summer and will replace BuyandSell.gc.ca/tenders
- Designed to make it easier for suppliers to find and understand government opportunities
- Testing with suppliers has shown significant improvements in usability from BuyandSell
- By September 2022, will cover all Canadian public sector entities, including provinces, territories, municipalities and public academic, social and health institutions
- We are working with provinces and territories to establish standards for tender data

Finding Opportunities

- As the Government of Canada (PSPC) transitions to the new procurement tools, commodities will be on-boarded in groups until summer 2021
- For now, all opportunities will continue to be posted to BuyandSell.gc.ca. You may see opportunities posted that will direct you to the SAP Ariba Network in order to view the details or submit a bid
- Suppliers with BuyandSell notifications enabled will be notified of e-procurement opportunities in the same way they do now
