Field technician rate includes: travel time in addition to the hours identified on site (in the 50km radius), travel expenses (in the 50km radius) and other expenses and tools required for all types of field tests (for example: compaction, concrete, aggregates, roofing, building cladding, welding, paving and other tests in civil engineering, building, dam, airport, marine or other).
