2. If hardcopies are required, please confirm if only one (1) hard copy submission is required or if one (1) original and five (5) hardcopy submissions (totaling 6 hardcopy submissions) are required.

3. Please clarify the timeline for the following:
 - Phase One results *estimate 3 weeks*
 - Phase Two RFP release *A week after the phase one results (estimate)*
 - Phase Two RFP deadline *TBD*
4. Please advise if we are able to include CV's as an Appendix? Will Appendices be counted toward the 30-page limit?
CV's will count towards the page limit.
5. Please advise if we can use divider pages. Please advise if these will be counted toward the 30-page limit.

6. Please confirm that Section 3.2.3 - Achievements of Key Personnel on Projects is required from the Proponent Team only and is not required from all members of the Consultant Team (i.e., sub-consultants and speciality consultants). *Yes*
7. Please confirm if all sub-consultants and specialists need to obtain a professional license/accreditation in the province of New Brunswick? *Only the Prime is required. For the prime consultant, indicate current license and/or how you intend to meet the provincial or territorial licensing requirements. In the case of a joint venture identify the existing or proposed legal form of the joint venture (refer to R1110T General Instructions to Proponents, GI9 Limitation of Submissions).*
8. Please confirm if sub-consultants and speciality consultants are precluded from bidding on future phases associated with this project. *No, see Amendment 1*
9. Would the client consider upping the page limit to 36 pages?
The page limit, for phase one, is hereby increased to 36 pages.

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10. does the indigenous architect fall under the “key-sub consultant” category and also have to provide 2 healthcare facilities completed in the last 8 years?
The indigenous architect is a key sub-consultant. For the indigenous architect only, the experience requirement of two completed health care facilities within the last eight years is removed. Proponents are encouraged to present experience in the field of health, healing, and wellness.
11. Due to the small number of registered Indigenous Architects in Canada, would you consider removing the preclusion for the successful Indigenous Architect in phase one to bid on phase two?
Preclusion removed, refer to Solicitation Amendment #1.
12. Would it be acceptable to use a project that is not completed (under construction) but the pre-design work is final? Or does the project need to be fully completed?
Non-completed projects may be included at the risk of being scored lower. Proponents are encouraged to clearly present how past experience aligns with the requirements of this RFP.
13. What is the intended delivery model for construction? (P3, design-build, design-bid-build)
Per the Project Brief, PD3 Description of Project, 3.4.2.5.15, the successful proponent shall make final recommendations on implementation strategy and delivery method following the evaluation of options.
14. Is it a requirement that the role of Indigenous Architect be filled by a resource listed in Annex “A” – IBP Capacity Assessment?
No, the provided list are known resources based on a capacity assessment. Interested architects may be added to the list by contacting the contracting authority identified on the tender notice. Qualifications must be clearly identified within the phase one proposal.
