This amendment is raised to answer questions from Offerors.

A. Questions and Answers

Q1. *“Is there a chance of getting a copy of the Parks IPMP?”*

A1. The specific National Park or National Historic Site IPMP will be made available with specific projects during the call-up process.

Q2. *“Pricing is listed as Per Crew Per Hour. What if your crew is 5 or a crew of 2?”*

A2. It is up to the Offeror to determine their crew size and price accordingly. PCA will not be setting a minimum number for the crew size.

Q3. *“Is there a weed map with weed density and the amount of hectares/ acres to be controlled?”*

A3. This will be project specific and will be provided during the call-up process.

Q4. *“Round trip travel should include all expenses for travel to the site and all expenses while there during the call-up?”*

A4. Correct. No additional costs will be allowed outside of the rates in the Standing Offer.

Q5. *“Re seeding, what is the methods required for each of the two methods. Re seeding by seed only and by seed plugs? And is there a % of either method that may be used?”*

A5. This will be site/call-up specific and will be identified during the call-up process.
