Amendment no. 001 is raised to provide a summary of the briefing provided to interested suppliers.

Advanced Distributed Combat Training System (ADCTS) Training Services

1. Key information on the ADCTS system

- a) The ADCTS simulator provides simulation and training capability to the CF-188 fighter fleet in the form of force generation, mission planning, and maintaining operational readiness.
- b) ADCTS supports a wide spectrum of CF-188 training including:
 - Initial Conversion training
 - Tactical flying
 - Advanced tactics and systems
- c) In particular, the ADCTS simulators allow aircrew to practice flight operations not normally possible or desirable in a live fly scenario. These include:
 - Seeing and reacting to hostile fire
 - Operating with heavy weapons, advanced sensors
 - Operating against realistic adversaries who look and react like the real thing
 - Repetition of complex or dangerous tasks and manoeuvres not normally possible in a live fly training mission
- d) ADCTS operations are conducted at ADCTS Mission Training Centers (MTC) located at 4 Wing Cold Lake and 3 Wing Bagotville.

2. Key information on existing contracts that support the ADCTS system and training

- a) The ADCTS simulator and maintenance support are provided through an existing long-term agreement with L3 Harris Link Simulation and Training Division.
- b) The training services used in conjunction with the ADCTS simulator are contracted separately through an existing contract with Séllect Global International Ltée (SGI). The current training services contract is set to expire in February 2022, however an option remains to extend that contract to February 2023.

3. Intent of the Request for Information (RFI)

- a) With the RCAF's decision to extend the life expectancy of the CF-188 (nominally until 2032), Canada has a need to re-compete the training services contract used in support of RCAF fighter pilot training for the CF-188.
- b) Canada plans in the near future to issue a Request for Proposal to establish a new contract with the following projected term:

- An initial 5 year contract period; and
 - Multiple optional contract periods as follows to extend the agreement as required:
 - i. Two irrevocable options for 2 year extensions;
 - ii. Two irrevocable options for 1 year extensions;
- c) Canada recently released the RFI on 07 May 2021 (with a closing date of 07 Jun 2021), which contains questions, a draft Statement of Work (SOW) that outline the projected requirements for the future RFP and the evaluation criteria for the resulting technical and financial proposals
- d) The highlights of the Statement of Work describing the requirement for instructional training services for the CF-188 ADCTS include:
- Provision of instructor pilots and console operators
 - Provision of instructional training services during the Training Availability Window
 - The capability to support surge training
 - The creation and management of mission training scenarios

Questions and Answers

1. What is the expected timeline for the follow-on Request for Proposal?
 - a. Estimated Request for Proposal release: Fall 2021
 - b. Estimated Contract Award: Spring 2022
2. What are the expected manning and work volume levels for the Additional Work Requirements (AWR) identified in the Statement of Work?
 - a. Approximated manning and work volume levels will be provided in the follow-on Request for Proposal.
3. Will this requirement transition into a requirement for the New Fighter Aircraft?
 - a. The proposed requirement is one that it solely linked to the ADCTS training simulators, which directly supports the RCAF's training requirements for the CF-188 aircraft.
