This amendment is raised to:

- A. Answer questions from bidders

### A. Questions and Answers

**Q1.** Will Parks Canada be planning on keeping the Bow Valley Parkway & Johnston Canyon Day use closed to vehicle traffic for the remainder of this upcoming summer due to Covid 19 or will this be changing. Has a direct bearing on the amount of public site use required for construction of this project.

**A1.** Private vehicle traffic on the Bow Valley Parkway is currently restricted, and is expected to remain restricted at least until Alberta reaches "Stage 3" of post-Covid resumption and all restrictions are lifted.

Note that the Johnston Canyon trail itself remains open, and is currently served by Roam Public Transit, and popular with cyclists. The Johnston Canyon Lodge and Bungalows is also open, and resort reservation holders are allowed to drive to the resort on the BVP.

The Bow Valley Parkway is currently closed to private motor vehicles between Johnston Canyon and Fireside Day-use Area, and this section is likely to remain closed for the remainder of summer 2021.
