Will you accept bids for Off-Site Document Destruction as well so long as we have the proper accreditations?

Answer 1:

No, we will not accept offers for offsite destruction.

Question 2:

In the Certification Section (Part 5) I don't see a requirement for the vendor to be AAA Naid Certified which ensures that the material is handled with the highest levels of security and ensures the resulting shredded paper is recycled properly. See <u>www.naidonline.org</u>

Can you confirm that this is a minimum requirement for all vendors, and if not, what is the minimum requirement of the destination of the resulting shredded paper?

Answer 2:

There is no direct requirement for companies to be AAA certified, only to meet the following RCMP standards.
