	When I look at the instructions for Completing the Personnel Security Screening Form on the government of Canada website, it asks NOT to complete the form unless a department or agency has requested to complete them.
	My question is: should I be completing it now as part or my bid submission or is it preferable to wait to see if I have won the bid before embarking on these forms?
A1	Security forms are not mandatory at the bidding submission stage. Forms can or not be completed and will only be processed with successful bidders prior to contract award.
