Amendment 002 is raised to answer questions from bidders.

- Q1.** Is the recycling single stream (paper and mixed containers together)?
A1. Yes.
- Q2.** Is the recycling mostly mixed containers (bottles/cans/glass/metal) with minimal paper?
A2. Yes.
- Q3.** Are there any organics bins present for food waste, dog waste, and soiled paper?
A3. No.
- Q4.** If there are no organics bins, would the park consider implementing a pilot program to collect food and dog waste to properly divert the materials and keep them out of the waste and recycling streams?
A4. No.
- Q5.** What type of vehicle and what are the operational details around servicing the Haul-All Hide-A Bags?
A5. Waste will be collected in bags by a PICKUP TRUCK and deposited in larger containers or transferred to garbage trucks for hauling.
- Q6.** Who is the current service provider?
A6. This is a new waste management system. We do not currently have a contract for service.
- Q7.** Can a portion of the work be bid on or will bids only be accepted if all pricing is accounted for?
A7. Bids will only be accepted if they include pricing for the full scope of work.
- Q8.** Are the current containers in an accessible location so that a service vehicle can drive up and service?
A8. Yes
- Q9.** Are any of the Hide a Bag consoles located on trails which would require an operator to walk a significant distance to service?
A9. No, vehicle access is within a few meters.
- Q10.** What type of equipment is currently being used to service the Hide-a-Bag containers?
A10. Pickup truck.
- Q11.** Could a map be provided showing the locations of each of the Moloks and Haul-Alls.
A11. Yes, see separately attached RNUP Waste Management Plan (park-wide) v.2.
