- Q1.** Can you please confirm the scope of Dangerous Goods Waste for the project is only from industrial activities and not from domestic/household sources which are in addition to industrial activities?
- A1.** The scope of the study is not entirely limited to industrial production. From the objective statement: This includes identifying sites that produce (generate) or collect DG wastes..., which refers to the identification of industrial source locations and identification of waste collectors / consolidators who handle both industrial and household waste of certain quantities and concentrations of DGs that pose a threat to human safety or the environment. While we do not require identification of individual locations where domestic DG waste is generated, it may be collected and consolidated at centralized locations, and then potentially moved forward to recycling and disposal.
- Q2.** Can Transport Canada please provide an indication as to the estimated level of effort in days for this project?
- A2.** Transport Canada anticipates the study to start in mid-August 2021 and conclude at the end of March 2022. As part of the bidder's proposal, it is required to submit a work plan identifying the timelines, activities and schedules to meet the stated deliverables.
