Q21	Under the sub-contractor section in the Technical Offer, it is indicated that "If the Consultant is employing a sub-contractor, a copy of the sub-contractor's proposal to perform their portion of the work. Proof of sub-contractor registration and professional insurance is to be provided with the Offer." Can you clarify what documentation is required for proof of sub-contractor registration? Would the company's Ontario Corporation Number suffice?
A21	Ontario Corporation Number will suffice. If the sub-contractor is a PGO or PEO registered company, please also specify in the proposal.
Q22	Section 3.2 Experience under R3 asks to include the description of max. 3 past completed projects and that 2 points will be awarded for each of the 4 listed criteria for each proposed personnel. Does this mean that a single project is sufficient to gain the full 8 points per personnel provided that the project covers the aspects for all the 4 listed criteria?
A22	Confirmed, If the Bidder would like to suggest up to maximum 3 past completed projects for each personnel, please specify which project the evaluation team shall take into consideration.
Q23	R5 Indigenous Consideration asks to provide one summary of previous work that involved First Nations participation. The last two sentences state: "Summary demonstrates how aboriginal hiring and training will be incorporated into work activities; (6 pt.)" and "Summary describes potential on-the-job training opportunities. (6 pt.)". Could you please clarify if these last two sentences refer to the same summary of previous work that involved First Nations participation listed above or if these are separate requirements/sections where the offeror should describe plans for these aspects for future projects as part of the SOA?
A23	The last two sentences relate to the previous work that involved First Nations participation. The summary shall demonstrate how similar (improved) or new, potential aboriginal hiring, training (on-the-job or class training) can be incorporated in the summarized project if it was to be carried out again.
