AMENDMENT #1

THE PURPOSE OF THIS AMENDMENT IS TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE FOLLOWING CHANGE;

1) Clarification to project schedule:

- Work can be started as soon as the contract is awarded and must be completed prior to December 31, 2021. Contractor to schedule their own work plan within this window with approval from the departmental representative.

The visitor season for Georges Island in 2021 began in June and extends into October. For June, July and August, the visitor schedule is 3 days a week: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Starting September 11th, the schedule switches to 2 days a week: Saturday and Sunday.

The work plan must accommodate the visitor schedule and leave the site clean and accessible for visitors during the visitation days. The contractor may choose to begin the Work after award based on a 4-day a week schedule, or delay start till at least September 7th and begin a 5-day a week schedule.
