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#### Question# 2

- 1. With reference to points R1.4 and R1.5:
  - R1.4, you are asking for experience of resources offered in French AND in English. Do you mean the experience in French OR in English, or is French only?
  - R1.5, you are asking for experience of resources offered in French only.

Please clarify the confusion of these two criteria please.

#### Answer #2

R1.4 is for three (3) years' experience in providing **Adult French Language** training.

R1.5 is for three (3) years' experience in providing Adult English Language training.

#### Question #3

For mandatory criteria M5, you require experience of French AND English training resources. Did you mean the experience in French OR English.

#### Answer #3

All three (3) Proposed Resources must have a minimum of 660 hours providing language training.

Two (2) Resources must have in total 660 hours in providing French language training; and

One (1) Resource must have in total 660 hours in providing English language training.

#### Question #4

**Question from Firm 1** - We wish to clarify elements in points R1.4 and R1.5. We understand that we need to demonstrate that the proposed resources have at least 3 years of experience teaching English and French, which is easy to do. However, some of the information relevant to the assessment appears to relate to the organization (AFSL Pro) and not to the resources, including:

- 3) Number of resources provided
- 6) Success rate for each contract

Would you like for each proposed resources we indicate the information for the points listed OR do we need to compile our data for each major contract?



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In addition, the number of hours provided by each resource and the skill level must already be indicated in point R1.3 (2 and 3). Should we repeat the information in points R1.4 (5) and R1.5 (5)?

**Question from Firm 2** - To the point rated technical criteria. In R1.4 and R1.5 if you ask to demonstrate the experience of each teaching resource in each contract, what is the relevance of point 3) Number of resources provided?

# Clarification on remaining criteria

Bid evaluation for R1.4 and R1.5 are not from any specific organization.

Proponent's should indicate the required information listed for each proposed resource(s).

What is required is that Proponents demonstrate that all Proposed Resource(s), including the three (3) required in Mandatory 5, for R1.4 French Language Training and R1.5 English Language training have participated in providing a minimum of three (3) years of language training, in the specific language that the Proponent is submitting them for. Documentation that could verify this criteria:

- 1) would the name of the organization that the Proposed Resource(s) providing training to,
- 2) the # of hours in which they provided training to that organization
- 3) the # of candidates that they provided language within that organization
- 4) What levels of language obtained if it was Federal organization and
- 5) What was the Proposed Resources success rate in regards to the candidates successfully meeting the desired level prior to training.

Hours should be provided for each contract that Proposed Resource(s) has worked on.

Question #5

**Question from Firm 1** At R1.4 when you say "All resources offered" does that include the resources offered in M5? If the answer is yes, it's going to require preparing a lot of experience tables from each resource and as a result it's a huge job and I believe the August 12th cut-off date is too short.

**Question from Firm 2** Could we ask you to extend the closing date of RFSO#84084-20-0083 as it takes a long time to prepare the responses to the mandatory and rated criteria, and given the summer season there are a lot of currently on vacation.

#### Clarification of criteria

Yes, "all resources offered" includes the three (3) required in M5 and any other additional Proposed Resource(s).

#### Question #6

Following the reading of the request for standing offers 84084-20-0083 – Language training services published on July 20, we would like to obtain the following details or highlight certain elements to be clarified.

- 1- In the mandatory criteria, page 10:
  - Criteria M2: The Bidder must propose at least three (3) resources: two (2) to provide training in French, and one (1) to provide training in English in Calgary, Alberta.
  - Does this mean that the three (3) resources Must be physically on site in Calgary or is online education (virtual mode) possible, in which case a qualified teacher who meets all the criteria all the criteria but does not live in Calgary could be eligible?
- 2- The wording of criteria R1.6 to R1.11 mentions: The tender must demonstrate that the proposed resource(s), other than that required in criteria M5,
  - -Are we to understand that 3 resources must be proposed for criteria of M5 (6600h French and English teaching level C at the federal level) but that we cannot in any way insert/suggest these resources in the descriptions according to the levels taught (R1.6 to R1.11)?
- 3- In addition, we noted some inconsistencies or questions remaining for the following elements:
  - Page 12-13 (R1.2 R1.3): the criteria describe how to get up to 10 points but there is a maximum of 15 points to get
  - Page 13 (R1.4): mentions French and English (should be English only since R1.5 is for French)?
  - Page 17: R1.12 and R1.13 are reversed
  - Page 17 (R1.12): the criteria describe how to obtain up to 20 points but there is a
    maximum of 25 points to be obtained the first 2 descriptions giving a total of 20 points
    despite the difference



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- Page 25 (7.3.1): from August XX, 2021 to August XX, 2021 (same year repeated twice)
- Page 31 (3.6): individual sessions/groups sessions ??
- Page 33 (4c-v.1.): Part-time training: report requested at the end of the training with hours during the month?
- Page 33 (4c.iv.2 and 3. And 4c-v.2 and 3): means student attendance times/scheduled class hours – is that correct?
- Page 35: cancellation before 7:30 m by teachers? What about the learners?

#### Answer #6

1 – Clarification: Any Federal Department or Agency must provide a candidate with the ability of in-class instruction. Not all candidates are able to learn by virtual in-person training.

# M2 Delete in its entirety.

**Replace with:** M2 Bidder's must ensure that there is at minimum of one (1) Proposed Resource who is physically in the following locations to provide French Language Training:

- 1) Vancouver, British Columbia and
- 2) Calgary, Alberta.

**Add:** M10 Bidder's must ensure that there is at minimum of one (1) Proposed Resource who is physically in the following locations to provide English Language Training:

- 1) Vancouver, British Columbia and
- 2) Calgary, Alberta.
- 2- There is no Pointed Rate Criteria that is a "must demonstrate" all Point Rate Criteria should indicate "should demonstrate..."

Clarification: M5 is to ensure that CER has at minimum three (3) instructors with 660 hours of language training to candidates to obtain any required Federal Language level (A,B,C,E) that can provide virtually until such time in-class training can be provided.

Criteria for R1.6 and R1.11 are criteria *is only for additional resource(s)*, should any of the mandatory three (3) are not available to provide training.

#### 3 – Clarification and corrections:

- R1.2 & R1.3 should read maximum obtainable allocated points is 10 points.
- R1.4 criteria is for experience in only providing French Language Training



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- R1.12 and R1.13 noted, but criteria is affected.
- R1.12- Maximum of 25 points is obtainable is accurately defined, as a Proposed Resource could have a University Degree for 20 points and in addition also have the TESL Canada Professional Certification for 5 points for maximum obtainable allocated points of 25 points. (see note indicated in apprentices).

#### Solicitation Document clarification and corrections:

 Article 7.3.1 Contract Period should indicate August XX, 2021 to August XX, 2022 (as per Basis of Payment)

#### Statement of Work clarification and corrections:

- 3.6 is for Individual Sessions
- Page 33 (4c-v.1) unsure what correction or clarification is required for this sub-article in the SoW. All session whether full-time or part-time requires a monthly progress report.
- Yes, this means candidates attendance, # of hours instruction was provide in the month and # of hours that were missed by either the candidate or instructor (should there be any hours missed in that particular month)
- Add to Responsibility of CER PA will advise the Contractor no later than 7:30 should a
  candidate not be able to attend that day's language training session.

#### Question #7
