Request for Quotation Amendment no. 001 is raised for the following reason:

To address a questions pertaining to the specifications

Question 1

With reference to following requirement, in Annex A – Statement of Requirement (SOR):

"Device Retention Warranty: To maintain the confidentiality of information that may be recorded or saved on the device requiring Hardware Maintenance Services, all devices requiring repair or replacement must remain in the possession of Canada. Faulty devices will not be returned to the Manufacturer, and Offerors need to factor that into their cost."

Allied Telesis needs the defective product for warranty coverage, they cannot accept above term. Would you please remove this requirement from solicitation?
