AMENDMENT #001

This amendment solicitation is raised to answer questions from the industry.

To answer questions #1 to #5 from the industry:

QUESTION #1:

The Mandatory Technical Criteria A9 illustrates the need for "Single Pass" this is a term only used by Zebra. The industry standard term is "Single Line". "Single Pass" scanning technology is commonly referred to devices that enable the simultaneous scanning of both sides of a document through a single pass of the scanning area.

As such, we require that Canada to remain in line with the SACC 2003 - Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements amend this to "Single Line" as a Scan Mode to meet other manufactures and the industry standard for barcode scanning compliance.

ANSWER #1:

Canada agrees to amend the Mandatory Technical Criteria A9 to be "Single Line" or "Single Pass"

QUESTION #2:

The Mandatory Technical Criteria A20 illustrates size specifications that are very specific to only a single scanning device on the market manufactured by Zebra (which is also deal registered and preferred pricing is only provided to a single vendor). We believe that this criteria should be amended to a more open and competitive bidding process by having the size specifications amended to allow for competitive devices to be bid and also for this to not be a sole sourced venture with a single manufacturer to allow for a competitive offering from other manufacturers and partners in the community.

As such, we request that Canada amend the scanner dimensions in A20 to the following dimensions:

Maximum size:

Width: 7 cm
Depth: 13 cm
Height: 15 cm

ANSWER #2:

Canada amended the barcode scanner dimensions as detailed in Mandatory Technical Criteria A20 to the following:

Maximum size:

Width: 7 cm
Depth: 13 cm
Height: 17 cm

QUESTION #3:

The Mandatory Technical Criteria A11 is specific to a single device from Zebra which is locked down with a single vendor to supply preventing any form of a competitive offering, we require Canada to amend the specifications for this to be a minimum resolution of 1280 X 800 pixels. This will allow for an open and competitive bid process from other manufacturers to meet the requirements.

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ANSWER #3

Canada agrees to amend the Mandatory Technical Criteria A11 to a minimum resolution of 1280 X 800 pixels.

QUESTION #4:

We would like to request if will be possible to get an estimated implementation date(s)/expected delivery date(s).

ANSWER #4:

QUESTION #5:

This is not an extension beyond the three (3) additional one (1) year period already referred to in Annex B, it is in reference to those option years.
