Questions and Answers

Question 13:

I do not understand why you require in M1 and in M4 that the resources must have experience at sea? Especially since you say you already have this resource on your team.

Answer 13:

In M1 and M4, "at sea" describes the type of search and resource for which we require expertise (as opposed to land-based search and rescue). The resource does not need experience physically "at sea".

Question 14:


Can you remove these two words (at sea) in M1 and M4?

<u>Answer 14:</u>

No, we will not remove the words "at sea" from M1 and M4 for the reason outlined in the answer to question 1.

Question 15:

In M4 what do you mean by: participated in at least one funded research project? Is funding an obligation?



Answer 15:

"funded project" refers to a project that was funded by a 3rd party (as opposed to self-funded). This is a requirement to ensure that the selected resource has professional industry experience related to SAR theory, including the evaluation of SAR optimization products.
