

Q29: What is the maximum number of bidders that will be short-listed for each Stream?

A29: There is no limit to the number of Supply Arrangement holders in each Stream.

Q30: Will an honorarium be offered with each RFP issued?

A30: No, there will not be an honorarium offered with each RFP issued. There is no work (ex. design) that needs to be completed in advance of a contract award. All work done for the project will be completed under the contract and paid for according to the Terms of Payment.

Q31: Annex D – Point Rated Criteria Scoring Grid, Item R1(a) – Team Organization Diagram - Can the Team Organization Diagram be submitted on 11 x 17 sized paper, and if so, will it count as one (1) page?

A31: Yes, the response to criteria R1-a may be submitted on one 11” x 17” sized paper and yes it will count as one (1) page.

Q32: Can Canada clarify whether the limitation of 5 pages is only for section M1 g)? Suppliers must provide a description of the project and scope of work or does the entire M1 section inclusive of a-j have to be presented within this 5 page limit? If the latter, given the amount of information (for M1 (a-j)) that the supplier needs to demonstrate to be compliant, the limit of 5 pages may not be possible.

Can the supplier address M1g) in these 5 pages and have no limitation of pages for the other M1 sections? Does the 5 page limit also include the title page?

A32: Please see Amendment 004 for edits to the Annex D - Evaluation Criteria Point Rated Scoring Grid and the Evaluation Criteria for Mandatory Criteria M1. The response to the Mandatory Criteria has a page limitation of 10 pages to provide all information for both project descriptions. The responses to the Point Rated Criteria have a total maximum page limitation of 30 pages. As per Question 31, the 30 pages for the Point Rated Criteria includes one 11”x17” page, which will count as one page. The page limitations do not include title pages, table of contents or certifications.

Q33: Annex D – Evaluation Criteria, Section M.1, Point h) – “The Supplier must explain the relationships between the project’s team members ...” Can PWGSC please define the term “team members” as referenced in this question? Is this meant to be firms or individuals?

A33: We are not seeking information on individuals.
