C. Questions and Answers

- Q1.** In relation to the above-mentioned Invitation to tender, it is stipulated in the specifications that the end date of phase 1 is scheduled for November 17, given that there is no paving, is it possible to postpone it?
- A1.** The end of phase 1 is dependent of the meteorological conditions observable on site during the works and according to the meteorological forecast to come at that time. Extension requests to postpone the end of phase 1 to a later date in 2021 must be made to the Agency Representative. The Agency Representative will approve the request only if the contractor has done due diligence to accomplish the work within the prescribed deadlines, if the contractor has justified the delays and if the quality of the work will not be impacted by the anticipated weather conditions.
