This Solicitation Amendment No. one (004) is raised to include the following addendum no. 004.

The following addendum to the tender documents is effective immediately. This addendum shall form part of the contract documents. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

Addendum No. 004. This invitation to tender is hereby amended to:

- (1) Reference: **Closing date appearing of page one of the solicitation document**
DELETE the closing date of **2021-10-21**; and
INSERT the revised closing date of **2021-10-26**.
- (2) Issue revisions to specification – see attached addendum 004.
- (3) Provide the following questions and answers - Question 1 to 22:

Q1 - Please add Altex-SunProject added to the supplier list for the window blinds for your project Parks Canada & Parole Board?

A1 - Specification is performance based, contractors are responsible to meet required specifications. Equivalents will be approved at the shop drawing stage.

Q2 - Draperies Section 12 22 13: The finish schedule for type WT1 does not call out a manufacturer or specific fabric. It says sheer to opaque. These are two totally different weights and types of fabrics. Do you want both or one or the other and if it is one or the other, can advise which one you want – sheer or opaque? Also, without a fabric specified, it will be very difficult to price, as everyone will be pricing different fabrics.

A2 - An allowance of \$1,500.00 (one thousand five hundred dollars) excluding taxes will be permitted for the fabric only for these draperies. Please see revised B03 of Appendix 1 – Bid and acceptance Form (BA) attached.

Q3 - Roller Window Shades Section 12 24 13: Are the blinds to have valances/fascias or are they to be open roll, meaning no valance/fascia? Also, in 2.2.2, the fabric is specified as SG Sunscreen 3% but then the fabric is specified as CS 101. That is a 1% open fabric. The 3% fabric is CS 103. Can you please confirm if you want a 3% or 1% open fabric?

A3 - Reference: Section 12 24 13 - Roller Window Shade:

Replace 2.2.2 to read as follows:

.2 Fabric: Woven SG Sunscreen 1%; CS 101, 25% polyester yarn, 75% PVC Fabric. Green Guard certified.

Add 2.2.4 as follows:

.4 Roller window shade to be complete with fascia cover system.

Q4 - Question about the demolition scope of work as per the sprinkler heads, Do we leave them as is until they are ready for new ceiling ?

A4 - Before any work is performed the contractor must comply with NFPA 25, Chapter 15 Impairments (This chapter provides a minimum requirement when system or part of are out of order). After the contractor has implemented these requirements, the heads should only be relocated/removed after the ceilings are in and the walls have been added.

Q5 – Please confirm that structured cabling for communications systems (telephone & data) is NOT part of RFQ and that RFQ only covers empty conduit for these systems as would appear to be supported by lack of spec for actual cabling. Typically structured cabling for voice & data is performed by Shared Services Canada through GMCS portal but would like to confirm as we are being asked by electrical contractors for pricing.

A5 - The electrical contractor is responsible for communications systems pathways only. The structured cabling for both the voice and data systems shall be performed by Shared Services Canada (ie. cabling, outlets, terminations, testing).

Q6 - Where is the fireproofing to be applied?

A6 - No fireproofing needed, only Firestopping. Fireproofing section deleted in Addendum

Q7 - Is the bench in Elevation 1 on Drawing ID 1.2 included in this scope? If so, please provide spec.

A7 - No, furniture is Not In Contract (N.I.C.)

Q8 - What is the height of the mobile storage (Realizing it needs to be 18" clear to the sprinkler).

A8 - Given the ceiling height and access floor height, the shelving unit shall be maximum 2000mm. See addendum.

Q9- How many dividers is the client expecting for the mobile storage?

A9 - 10 dividers per shelf.

Q10- Only one (1) Reference Shelf is noted in the description for the Mobile Storage, should it be one (1) per section?

A10 - One shelf per 300mm of height. See Addendum.

Q11 - Please confirm the floor requirement for the mobile storage. Low profile Rail on the floor (no ramp) or a plywood subfloor ramped

A11 - As per Detail 2 on drawing ID 1.2, Rails are installed on beams. Floor to be access-flooring around beams

Q12 - How many parking spaces will be provided by Public Works?

A12 - PSPC does not provide any parking spaces.

Q13- What would be the location we would be allowed to place a garbage bin?

A13 - Garbage bins must be delivered and taken away every day. They cannot remain on-site during the day. They can be delivered at 5pm and must be taken away by 7am the next morning.

Q14- Will there be an elevator assigned to the GC?

A14 - A freight elevator is available for use by contractors and is assigned for construction

Q15- Please provide the manufacturer of both the flooring and wall tile.

A15- The product specifications are performance based. No specific manufacturers will be provided. The General Contractor is responsible to select products which meet specifications.

Q16 - Is structured cabling part of this tender or is this scope of work to be performed by Shared Services Canada?

A16 - Structured cabling is not part of this tender. Electrical contractor is responsible for communications pathways only. Structured cabling by Shared Services Canada.

Q17 - Is there a furred out second wall in the small meeting room 3389, along wall W2?

A17 - Yes, the furred wall is type 'W4'.

Q18 - As far as the owner furniture (workstations, etc.) will this be supplied by the owner and installed by the GC, or are we responsible to schedule the time for the owner to supply and install the furniture.

A18 - PSPC will be supplying and installing the furniture. The GC only has to allow time in the schedule for this activity as we will need his electrician to connect the workstations to the power supply.

Q19 – Please clarify if the cabling is part of the tender package. The drawings indicate the amount of cables required but there is nothing in the specification other than the pathways for the cables. Can you confirm if the structured cabling is part of the tender?

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A19 - The electrical contractor is responsible for communications systems pathways only. The structured cabling for both the voice and data systems shall be performed by Shared Services Canada (ie. cabling, outlets, terminations, testing).

Q20- There seems to be some confusion with the parole board/parks job. Is this to be priced in 2 separate sections or as one.

A20 - It is 1 contract for 2 projects. So 1 (one) lump sum price to build both suites.

Q21 - The flooring subcontractors are asking for the Manufactures and products for the flooring finishes on the job. (Especially the sheet flooring and the tile).

A21 - Specification is performance based, contractors are responsible to meet required specifications. Equivalents will be approved at the shop drawing stage.

Q22 – Is structured cabling was part of the tender for Parole Board and Parks Canada Fit-up or not.

A22 - The electrical contractor is responsible for communications systems pathways only. The structured cabling for both the voice and data systems shall be performed by Shared Services Canada (ie. cabling, outlets, terminations, testing).
