# **REQUEST FOR QUOTATION AMENDMENT NO. 002**

Request for Quotation Amendment no. 002 is raised for the following reason

- To address Technical Questions regarding Annex C
- To replace Title Name of Annex C

## Question 003

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #1.5, #2.5, #3.5, #4.5 Will the government accept a 10 foot input cord?

# Answer 003

SSC will accept a 10 foot input cord for requirements 1.5, 2.5, 3.5 and 4.5 as it exceeds the specified length in these requirements.

# **Question 004**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #1.6 Will the government accept 6 x Nema 5-15R?

# Answer 004

SSC will not accept six NEMA 5-15R outlets for requirement 1.6 as it does not meet the requirement.

# **Question 005**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

#1.10, #2.9, #3.9, #4.9 Will the government accept 10/100 mb/s Network Card?

# Answer 005

SSC will not accept a 10/100MbE network card for requirements 1.10, 2.9, 3.9 and 4.9. Modern network switches increasingly do not support Fast Ethernet and this limitation would prevent the implementation of network-managed uninterruptible power supplies in multiple scenarios.

# **Question 006**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #1.17, #2.16, #3.16, #4.16 As locations have not been specified as to where the UPS units are going to be installed will the government accept a best delivery scenario based on distance from a warehouse with advance replacement?

# Answer 006

SSC acknowledges that next-business-day delivery is not possible in many remote locations. The bidder must include the warranty option where next-business-day replacement is provided in major Canadian metropolitan areas.

# **Question 007**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #2.2 Will the government accept a 4 minute runtime @ 1800 watts load?

# Answer 007

SSC has modified the requirement to reflect a more typical load for this type of device. Please see revised Annex C – Amendment 001

# Question 008

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

#3.2 Will the government accept a 4 minute runtime @ 2700 watts load?

# Answer 008

SSC has modified the requirement to reflect a more typical load for this type of device. Please see revised Annex C – Amendment 001

# Question 009

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

 #4.1 Will the government accept a lower VA as long as we can meet the real power capacity in 4.2?

# Answer 009

SSC will not accept a product that does not meet or exceed the power rating requirement.

## Question 010

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

#4.17 Will the government accept a 5U Height?

# Answer 010

SSC will not accept a 5U device for requirement 4.17 as it exceeds the specified maximum for this requirement.

# **Question 010**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #10.4 Can the government expand on the requirement for dry contact status? Can this be provided on the UPS instead of the Sensor?

# Answer 011

The requirement is for the sensor module to be able to report coming into contact with a liquid. The intent is to be able to detect when, for example, flooding starts to occur.

The module must integrate with the UPS but the dry-contact status point must remain on the Environmental Sensor Module so placement can be optimized for the environment.

# **Question 012**

Can you please advise on the following question regarding Annex C List of Requirements.

- #12.1 Will the government accept a 5-20P input on the PDU as an alternative?

# Answer 012

SSC will not accept a NEMA 5-20P input plug for requirement 12.1. The PDU is intended for 15 Ampere circuits.
