1	<i>I was wondering if there is a geotechnical report available for this solicitation ? With the package as is , I don't see anywhere in the tender package how the contractors are to deal with solid rock excavation and / or unsuitable trench materials if encountered . If there is no geotechnical report available for this tender , perhaps a unit price rate for Trench Rock and Imported Trench backfill would enable the contractors to bid this work.</i>
<b>Response</b>	No geotechnical report is available for this solicitation. Rock excavation will not be paid extra, so bidders are to build this into their lump sum price.
2	<i>Will rock excavation be paid as an extra should we encounter rock? Or is this to be built into our bid price? There is no rock profile or test pits mentioned on the drawings or specifications and was hard to tell from seeing the top of ground during the site visit.</i>
<b>Response</b>	No geotechnical report is available for this solicitation. Rock excavation will not be paid extra, so bidders are to build this into their lump sum price.
3	<i>It is our understanding that the Waterford River Tributary may be habitat to Brown Trout. If this is the case, it is also our understanding that in-stream works in such habitats are not permitted from October 1st to November 30th. Were there any Construction Timing Windows identified during DFO project review?</i>
<b>Response</b>	For bidding purposes, assume no in-stream work until after November 30th.
4	<i>In general, the City of Mount Pearl will not issue Street Excavation Periods between November 1st and May 1st . Has the Owner of this project obtained an exemption from the City of Mount Pearl to excavate &amp; connect to the existing water main, and reinstate asphalt &amp; concrete curb on Commander Place after November 1, 2021?</i>
<b>Response</b>	Contractor must apply for street excavation permit. No formal exemption has been given, however contractor is to reinstate asphalt and concrete curb on Commander Place prior to snow clearing operations.

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5	<i>Tender Documents state, "The Contractor must perform and complete the Work within 12 weeks from the date of notification of the acceptance of the offer". Realistically, the earliest this project could start following award, submittals and material acquisition is early December; in possible freezing conditions. Would it be acceptable to start this project in the Spring of 2022?</i>
<b>Response</b>	Intent is to have this contract work started immediately, starting in the area of Commander Place such that work to reinstate asphalt & concrete curb on Commander Place is completed prior to snow clearing operations.
