Janitorial service for Canadian Forces Base - North Bay

This amendment was raised to answer a question and update the Request for Proposal and extend the closing date to 5 January, 2022:

Question:

There is a Mandatory Criteria that has been put in the RFP which states that companies must be CIMS certified. This is the first PWGSC procurement that has been issued with this mandatory criterion, there has been NO notice of planned procurement issued providing companies advanced notice of the requirement which would give the necessary time to obtain said certification. Effectively Public Works is eliminating the competition that would be able to bid on this project.

Being that this is a new requirement sufficient time should be provided to ALL companies to obtain the certification OR this mandatory requirement should be removed entirely.

Answer:

Canada is not willing to remove the ISSA/CIMS certification as this accreditation Justifies the required Plans, Programs and procedures for (but not limited to):

- A quality assurance plan
- Service quality measurements
- Inspections (both contractor and customer)
- Complaints
- Customer evaluation and feedback
- Evaluation of progress and continuous improvement plan
- Service delivery plan
- Work plan instructions and emergency response
- Human resource policy
- Site specific orientation
- Personnel training
- Workplace Health Safety and Environmental plan
