
Title: Mock-Up Perimeter Wall Construction for the High Commission of Canada in India, in New Delhi

The following Questions & Answers is in link with the solicitation document mentioned above.

Questions & Answers #1

- **Q**1. "Kindly confirm the proposal delivery should not be later than 14:00 Easter Standard Time (EST) on November 5, 2021 i.e. 23:30 Indian Standard Time (IST) on November 5, 2021.?"
- Please see Addendum #1 for extended closing date. Eastern Standard Time (EST) is the time used for **A1.** the closing date.
- "Kindly elaborate the following: Respondent will be required to adhere to strict requirements related Q2. to construction contracts in general as well as to specific security protocols necessitated by an operating HCC complex on a 24 hours' x 7 days per week basis.?"
- There is no requirement for the Contractor to conduct work on a 24 hours' x 7 days per week basis. A2. The Contractor must be prepared to work around the requirement that the High Commission remains operational on a 24 hours' x 7 days per week basis.
- Q3. "Kindly reconfirm if the On-Line Document Management - DFATD system is to be used to facilitate the project management for the perimeter wall."
- A3. The Contractor will be granted access to the Central Collab, GAC's Secure File Share platform for online document management throughout the duration of the project.
- **Q**4. "Kindly clarify what is meant by 'reached substantial completion' for the exterior perimeter wall construction project to be submitted."
- Substantial completion is defined as the point in the project when the work is ready for use or is being used for the purpose intended and is so certified by a Consultant.
- "Kindly reconfirm that one can apply as a Joint Venture if not all but at least one party has been a **Q**5. General Contractor for the exterior perimeter wall construction projects to be submitted."
- Yes, a party may apply as a Joint Venture, so long as in the mandatory criteria they clearly identify their role as a General Contractor for all projects submitted.
- Q6. "Kindly reconfirm the project value of \$350,000/- Canadian includes the wall and affiliated items like CCTV, lights, conduits, Plumbing etc."
