This Amendment revises the GCCS – Stream 2 (CCaaS) RFSA Refresh released by SSC on October 5, 2021. The GCCS – Stream 2 (CCaaS) RFSA remains unchanged, except as explicitly amended by this document.

This Bid Solicitation Amendment No. 003 is raised to:

1 – Publish Canada's response to Industry questions; and

2 – Amend the RFSA document to introduce Applicability of COVID-19 vaccination requirements to individual solicitations in Requests for Supply Arrangements (RFSAs); and

3 – Amend Annex K - Resulting Contract Clauses, Supplemental General Conditions to introduce clauses related to COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel; and

4 – Amend Annex K – Resulting Contract Clauses to introduce the COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Certification; and

5 – Amend Form 2: CCaaS Software Publisher Authorization Form, changing the terminology from Reseller to Respondent;

1) Publish Canada's response to Industry questions:

Amd 001			
Q1	Would we be able to request an extension for submission? An extra 3-4 weeks would better empower us to engage our partner ecosystem and work on a potential joint-submission process.		
A1	Due to operational requirements and by virtue of this being the 2 nd round Refresh, Canada does not intend to extend the RFSA at this time.		
Q2	Can companies from Outside Canada can apply for this? (from India or USA)		
A2	Respondents outside of Canada may submit to this RFSA but must meet the Mandatory Requirements as per Annex B and Annex C.		
Q3	Will we need to come over there for meetings?		
A3	There are no meetings anticipated for this RFSA phase. If this changes, Canada will host meetings virtually.		
Q4	Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside Canada? (like, from India or USA)		
A4	Please clarify the tasks being referenced.		
Q5	Can we submit the proposals via email?		
A5	Per the RFSA, Respondents must submit their Responses through the P2P Portal.		
Q6	Can you confirm the number of CCaaS agents?		
A6	Canada will not provide the requested information at this time. Numbers of users/agents will be identified in any subsequent RFP issued to pre-qualified Suppliers under the Supply Arrangement.

Q10	I am trying to get the English version of the document, but I can't seem to find it within Merx. I have done the registration on the buy & sell site mentioned but have not received approval on that yet.

Q11	Will the contact centres be processing credit card payments? If so, will PCI DSS be a requirement?
A11	PCI DSS is not currently a requirement. There is a possibility PCI DSS becomes a requirement at a later date per individual RFPs under the Supply Arrangement.
Q12	We will need a 2-week extension to submit the proposal.
A12	Canada has extended this solicitation to November 15, 2021 at 2pm Eastern as of this amendment.
Q13	Can you please confirm if an NDA has been signed between xxx and Canada for this RFx?
A13	Canada has not signed a NDA with any Suppliers for this RFSA and cannot comment on previous NDAs. If a NDA is required in this process, it will be provided.
Q14	At RFP stage a NDA may be a requirement as per SCSI assessment. On page 22 of the RFSA, it indicates Annex E is mandatory. Please clarify?
A14	Respondents must provide clearances as proof that their organization and personnel meet the Annex E - SRCL requirements.
	Although mandatory to be provided at RFSA closing, it will not be a condition of SA award if the SRCL security requirements are not met.

Q15	Throughout the documentation there are reference to ISO 27001, ISO 27017, ISO 27002, ISO 17020, SOC 2 Type 2, as well as all the requirements for the Guardrail assessments.	

	Can there be confirmation that all of these contifications are required? If as
	Can there be confirmation that all of these certifications are required? If so, can SSC detail why they require certifications that cover the same requirements (example ISO 27001 and SOC 2, Type 2)?
A15	All 3 certifications are required annually. Although ISO and SOC2 are similar in nature, they each provide different information that SSC Security Management requires as part of their assessments.
Q16	Would Canada please change Form 2: CCaaS Software Publisher Authorization this to: "identify all of the Licensing Entities' proprietary CCaaS that are proposed by the Respondent".
A16	Form 2: CCaaS Software Publisher Authorization Form has been amended as of RFSA Amd 003 release.
Q17	The reference requirements are too steep for us to meet given the relatively new service offerings being asked for.
A17	Canada will not reduce the experience requirements. The experience requirements have already been reduced since the previous RFSA Refresh process, to take into account that the service is new.
	Canada requires that suppliers on the SA have the level of breadth and scope of experience required to support SSC's enterprise clients.
	As the vehicle is a Supply Arrangement, there will be opportunities to refresh on an annual basis and allow suppliers to get onto the vehicle at later dates should their business evolve and the experience requirements be attained.

3) Amend Annex K – Resulting Contract Clauses, insert Supplemental General Conditions related to COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel, as follows:

INSERT: Supplemental General Conditions:

4013 (2021-10-19) - Compliance with on-site measures, standing orders, policies, and rules applies to and forms part of the Contract applies to and forms part of the Contract.

A3080T – COVID-19 vaccination requirement:

This requirement is subject to the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel. Failure to complete and provide the COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Certification as part of the bid will render the bid non-responsive

A3015C: Certifications – Contract:

Compliance with the certifications provided by the Contractor in its bid is a condition of the Contract and subject to verification by Canada during the term of the Contract. If the Contractor does not comply with any certification or it is determined that any certification made by the Contractor in its bid is untrue. whether made knowingly or unknowingly, Canada has the right, pursuant to the default provision of the Contract, to terminate the Contract for default.

A3081T – COVID-19 vaccination requirement certification:

In accordance with the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel, all Bidders must provide with their bid, the COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Certification attached to this bid solicitation, to be given further consideration in this procurement process. This Certification incorporated into the bid solicitation on its closing date is incorporated into, and forms a binding part of any resulting Contract.
