Questions and Answers

- Q1. Can you give examples for M2 as what is considered operational positions? Please provide examples.
- A1. Officers maintain a listening watch in an operational environment either 8 or 12 hour shifts. They are responsible for radio (voice) communications as well as monitoring incoming email and maintaining a watch on radar like systems.
- Q2. Can candidates be trained in Nunavut instead of Nova Scotia since they will be closer to home and not away from home for 6 months?
- A2. Unfortunately not at this time. It is a National Program and some of the training i.e. simulator training is performed at the Canadian Coast Guard College. Some of the initial theory training is performed online before going to the college.
- Q3. What is the minimum number of Inuit candidates?
- A3. We do not have a minimum number set, however we would like to attract people who would like to do this type of work.
- Q4. In the event that the Inuit candidates are unable to pass the exams what is the impact on the training provider in terms of successful completion of the contract?
- A4. There is no impact on terms of successful completion. We are looking at attract candidates that will be in a better position to pass the aptitude test.
- Q5. Based on our discussions with potential candidates the typing speed requirement is most likely too difficult, is there any flexibility in the typing speed requirement?
- A5. No – At this time the minimum typing speed as indicated is a national standard.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
