It is recommended that the Bidder or a representative of the Bidder visit the work site. Arrangements have been made for the site visit to be held at 44, Route du Long-Sault, Saint-André-D'Argenteuil, QC, J0V 1X0 on November 17, 2021. The site visit will begin at 10:00 AM EST.

This site visit is subject to the *COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel*. Bidders will be requested to sign an attendance sheet. No alternative appointment will be given to bidders who do not attend or do not send a representative. Bidders who do not participate in the visit will not be precluded from submitting a bid. Any clarifications or changes to the bid solicitation resulting from the site visit will be included as an amendment to the bid solicitation.

It is important to note that, due to COVID-19, a maximum of one representative per company may attend the site visit. If a large enough number of bidders are interested in attending, Parks Canada may decide to welcome bidders at pre-determined times in order to respect physical distancing protocols.
