It is recommended that the Bidder or a representative of the Bidder visit the work site. Arrangements have been made for the site visit to be held at 640 Chebucto Head Road, Duncans Cove, Nova Scotia, on December 1, 2021. The site visit will begin at 13:00 AST.

Any clarifications or changes to the bid solicitation resulting from the site visit will be included as an amendment to the bid solicitation.
