## UNIT PRICE TABLES

### EVALUATION OF PRICE

The Contractor will be paid for actual hours worked/operated, at the firm rate detailed in the Unit Price Tables. Each item specified in the Unit Price Table includes hourly rates, traveling time and travel costs, allowances, supervision, liabilities as employer, insurance, and the use of all equipment, tools, tackle, etc., overhead, profit and all other liabilities whatsoever. The rates will be firm for the full period of the Standing Offer.

Unspecified Material shall be reimbursed at net cost, as supported by invoices, plus Markup as established in the Price Schedule of this Offer. "Net Cost" means all amounts reasonably and properly paid by the Offeror in respect of materials required for and used in the Work, and includes packing, handling and delivery charges, less any trade discounts received by the Offeror. The Offeror's Markup on Unspecified Material covers overheads, profit, and all other expenses whatsoever.

Payment by Canada for the Offeror's extraordinary field supplies and/or field equipment that is required at the job site may be allowed on a case by case basis with prior approval. The equipment will be no greater than the local going rental rate for such equipment or the rate published by the local construction association for such equipment, whichever is the lower. If the extraordinary field supplies or internal equipment charge is Contractor owned, proof that Contractor rates are industry competitive must be provided. Extraordinary field supplies and internal equipment charges must be specifically identified in the request for proposal.

Disbursements must be project related and must NOT include expenses that are related to the normal operations of the Contractor business. The following costs must be included in the fees required to deliver the services and will NOT be reimbursed separately. These include: computer, cell phones, personal protection equipment etc.

The cost of subcontract work, including the extraordinary field equipment rentals approved by the Project Authority, shall be reimbursed at actual cost, as supported by invoices, plus Markup as established in the Price Schedule of this Offer and covers overheads, profit, and all other expenses whatsoever. "Actual cost" means all amounts reasonably and properly paid by the Contractor for those parts of the Work carried out by subcontractors.

The unit prices and hourly rates requested in the offer and acceptance for specific types of service shall be the total cost to perform the work including:

- labour including supervision, allowances and liability insurance;
- travel time;
- transportation/vehicle expenses; meals and hotel costs (excluding air fare)
- tools and tackle;
- administration, overhead and profit;
- any other incidental expenses other than supply of materials and replacement parts relating to the delivery of labour.

The price of bids will be evaluated in Canadian dollars, the Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The Offeror agrees that the Unit Prices govern in calculating the Total Evaluated Price. The Offeror understands that any errors in the extension of the Unit Prices will be corrected by Canada.

These fixed hourly rates must be used by the contractor when creating price quotes. These fixed rates will remain in effect for the duration of the Standing Offer.
