Description of Work:

The Government of Canada launched an initiative across all departments to transform the way information is managed, shared and secured, led by the Treasury Board Secretariat (TBS) and Shared Services Canada (SSC).

To meet this, IM&TS has a requirement to consolidate and develop corporate and operational applications. IM&TS will require support in the development of the proposed solution in addition to support a diverse set of applications using a broad range of technologies that could include, but not limited to, the following:
