## AMENDMENT 1

This amendment is issued to reflect the following.

1. Add the following:

### Optional Site Visit

It is recommended that the Bidder or a representative of the Bidder visit the work site. Arrangements have been made for the site visit to be held at CFB Halifax - Dockyard on Thursday, January 13, 2022. The site visit will begin at 10:30 a.m. AST, at the Admiral Gate.

This site visit is subject to the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel. The person(s) who attend must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, or, for personnel that are unable to be vaccinated due to a certified medical contraindication, religion or other prohibited grounds of discrimination under the *Canadian Human Rights Act*, subject to accommodation and mitigation measures that have been presented to and approved by Canada.

Bidders must communicate with the Contracting Authority no later than 10:00 a.m. ADT Wednesday, January 12, to confirm attendance and provide the name(s) of the person(s) who will attend. Bidders must also complete and submit the following certification:

Bidders who do not participate in the visit will not be precluded from submitting a bid. Any clarifications or changes to the bid solicitation resulting from the site visit will be included as an amendment to the bid solicitation.

## **2. Responses to Bidder Questions**

Q1      Truck Scale – do you want a concrete deck or steel deck; and what is the width and length?

A1      Steel Deck – measurements can be taken during the site visit

Q2      If it is a steel deck, what is the deck thickness?

A2      Deck thickness is 3/8".

Q3      Weigh bar is a trade mark name for the weigh tronix proprietary load cell. Does DND want proprietary cells, if not; then are we required to provide proof of interchangeable cells?

A3      DND requires proprietary cells.

Q4      If we need to supply new badges for the kiosk, how many are required?

A4      Approximately 10 cards should work for both scales.

Q5      Does the kiosk have a printer? If yes, what information is printer, how many copies are printed?

A5      The card is inserted and it generates one printed slip.

Q6      Does the kiosk have to retain transaction data?

A6      Yes

Q7 If yes to question 6, how is the transaction data to be exported.

A7 Transactions are stored in the memory of the card ID.

Q8 What information are the drivers required to input, if any?

A8 The driver scans the card during the entering and exiting of the scale, nothing to my knowledge is entered other than pushing the button to get the slip to print.

Q9 If there is a printer, what paper size is required?

A9 Information not available at this time, but can be available during the site visit.

Q10 What is the required/expected downtime for the installation?

A10 DND is hoping the installation can occur in one week to avoid delays and re-routing of trucks.

Q11 What are the physical dimensions of the truck scale at CFB Halifax, ie. length and width.

A11 This can be measured during the site visit.

Q12 For removal and disposal purposes, what is the weight of the current truck scale at CFB Halifax?

A12 DND does not have this information.

Q13 Is this an above ground or pit scale?

A13 Above ground.

Q14 What information are the kiosks at both locations required to record?

A14 Record weight in and out of trucks that go on the scale.

Q15 The tender specifies "weigh-bars", these are only offered by Avery Weight-Tronix – this is their term for a load cell. Can the wording be changed to say "load cell" in the interest of other bidders so that there's no confusion.

A15 "Load cell" term may be used; however, DND requires the proprietary cells.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
