Consult Specifications for standards to be followed. Solid Wood is maple with natural finish with sealer. Note that edging for all solid wood will be 10mm as described in Section 06 20 00, 3.4 Installation of Shelving.2. Section 06 47 00 Plastic Laminate Finishing is revised and reissued with this addendum. Revisions and additions are indicated in bolded, italic text.
