Question 1:

Page 22 of 35 of the RFSO indicates that Senior Resources “Must have graduated with a degree from a recognized university with a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Sciences, earth sciences, or a Bachelor of Engineering in fields related to water quality and/or wastewater effluent monitoring.” Does a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry satisfy this requirement?

Response 1: Yes.

Questions 2:

Page 23 of 35 of the RFSO indicates that Intermediate Resources “Must have graduated with a degree from a recognized university with a Bachelor of Science or Environmental Studies or a Bachelor of Engineering in fields related to water quality and/or wastewater effluent monitoring.” Does a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Environmental Studies satisfy this requirement?

Response 2: Yes.

Question 3:

Addendum 1, Question 1 indicates that the offeror can propose additional resources than the required number stated in the RFSO, but only the required number of resources will be evaluated. For the proposed additional resources, does the offeror still need to include evidence of experience and education? For example, should the offeror include 2 project/contract references, a CV and copies of certificates for each additional resource?

Response 3: Yes.

Question 4:

What is the estimated dollar value of work expected to arise from this SOA? If possible, can PSPC disclose how much of this estimate is labour costs versus analytical costs?

Response 4: No financial information will be shared.

Question 5:

Can the offeror bid with a subconsultant using the subconsultant’s projects and staff to meet the mandatory technical requirements outlined in the RFSO under 4.1.2.1 Offeror’s Experience and Past Performance and 4.1.2.2 Resource Experience and Past Performance?

Response 5: No.

Please refer to Section 04 (2008-12-12) *Definition of Offeror* of the 2006 (2020-05-28) Standard Instructions which states:

"Offeror" means the person or entity (or, in the case of a joint venture, the persons or entities) submitting an offer to provide goods, services or both under a call-up resulting from a standing

offer. It does not include the parent, subsidiaries or other affiliates of the Offeror, or its subcontractors.

Question 6:

If a prime/sub relationship is used for this bid, do both parties require to meet the relevant security and insurance requirements?

Response 6: Yes.

Question 7:

How will Section 7 of the RFSO be used to evaluate if the offeror meets the mandatory technical requirements related to potable water, surface water, wastewater, legionella? As an example, will offerors be required to show evidence of experience related to section 7.9 in their project examples, given that it does not necessarily fall under any specific category?

Question 8:

Page 15 of 35 of the RFSO indicates that the contractor must have one (1) CAD Support Technician and one (1) Administrative Resource. Is providing the name and a copy of proposed individual's CV sufficient evidence to demonstrate the offeror meets this requirement?

Response 8: Yes, but their resume will not be evaluated.

2. Add 3.1.4 under Part 3 Section IV Additional Information following 3.1.3.2 :

3.1.4 In Section IV of their offer, offerors should provide:

1. their legal name;
2. their Procurement Business Number (PBN);
3. the name of the contact person (provide also this person's mailing address, phone and facsimile numbers and email address) authorized by the offeror to enter into communications with Canada with regards to their offer, and any contract that may result from their offer;
4. for Part 2, article 3, Former Public Servant, of the Request for Standing Offer: the required answer to each question; and, if the answer is yes, the required information;
5. for Part 6, article 1, Security Requirement, of the Request for Standing Offer:
 - a) Employee information security; and
6. Offerors who submit an offer as a joint venture must indicate clearly that it is a joint venture and provide the following information:
 - a. the name of each member of the joint venture;
 - b. the Procurement Business Number of each member of the joint venture;
 - c. the name of the representative of the joint venture, i.e. the member chosen by the other members to act on their behalf, if applicable;
 - d. the name of the joint venture, if applicable.
