QUESTION 2:

Do page number 40 - 43 need to be completed by us?

RESPONSE 2:

No, you do not need to complete pages 40-43. Annex D – Security Requirement Check List (SRCL) is for your information only. It is provided to ensure security requirements were addressed.

QUESTION 3:

The RFP indicates the Applicable law is for Canada but since the work will be executed in India, we cannot follow the Canadian Law. We shall follow The Applicable Law per Indian law. Please revise RFQ & revert so we can bid immediately

RESPONSE 3:

2. DELETE IN ITS ENTIRETY:

Article 1.1 Introduction on page 4 of the RFP.

INSERT:

1.1 INTRODUCTION

The bid solicitation is divided into 5 parts plus attachments and annexes, as follows:

Part 1 General Information: provides a general description of the requirement;

Part 2 Bidder Instructions: provides the instructions, clauses and conditions applicable to the bid solicitation;

Part 3 Bid Preparation Instructions: provides Bidders with instructions on how to prepare their bid;

Part 4 Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection: indicates how the evaluation will be conducted, the evaluation criteria that must be addressed in the bid, and the basis of selection; and

Part 5 Resulting Contract Clauses: includes the clauses and conditions that will apply to any resulting contract.

Attachment 1 to Part 3 includes the Certifications, Attachment 1 to Part 4 includes the Evaluation criteria.
