1. Optional Site Visit

ANNEX "A"

STATEMENT OF WORK

Title

The Supply & Install of a Truck Scale and display unit kiosk at CFB Halifax Dockyard and display unit kiosk replaced at 12Wing Shearwater.

Objective

The removal and replacement of a Bridgemont Heavy Duty Scale and display unit, that is located at CFB Halifax Dockyard and the display kiosk at 12Wing Shearwater replaced.

Background

The truck scale has been in place for over fifteen (15) years. Over time it has deteriorated due to weather and the regular wear and tear. The steel plate of the scale is starting to rust, has hole and has become a safety concern/hazard. The display unit kiosk at both locations are also outdated and/or obsolete and in need of replacing

Scales are used daily and volume consists of 3 to 5 trucks per day. Trucks weighed have varying configurations, such as garbage, recycling, compost, and generally freight.

Scope

The contractor must dismantle and dispose of the current truck scale. The contractor must supply and install a new 100 Ton truck scale and display unit in the same location as the old one. The contractor will be responsible for the proper disposal of the old scale and shipping and installation of the new scale. In addition, the contractor is to upgrade display kiosk in Shearwater with a unit that is compatible with current scale

Tasks

The contractor must dismantle and dispose of the old truck scale and kiosks in accordance with provincial environmental recycling and disposal regulations and supply and install a new scale and display unit located at CFB Halifax Dockyard and replace Display Kiosk at 12Wing Shearwater with unit that is compatible with current Bridgemont Heavy Duty Scale.

Constraints

Security

For security reasons, the work site requires that the contractor must obtain a Contractor Access Pass prior to entry to CFB Halifax and 12 Wing Shearwater. The Project Authority requires a minimum of ten business days notification prior to the delivery date at each site, in order to ensure a Contractor Access Pass can be processed in time for the contractor.

Existing Equipment

Scale in Shearwater is in good condition and is not being replaced at this time. Requirement for this location is for replacement of Display Kiosk only which must be compatible and functional with existing Beaumont Heavy Duty Scale.

Deliverables

- All junction boxes must be stainless steel construction and NEMA 4X
- The weigh bar must be Weigh-Tronix for compatibility with the current Kiosk in CFB Shearwater.
- Each Weigh Bar must come complete with stainless steel sheathed cable
- All Weigh-Bars to be connectorless and wired with tinned leads to the junction box terminal strips
- Summation boxes to have corner potentiometers for easy calibration
- Overload safety factor 200%
- All Weigh-Bars to have a 5-layer seal to eliminate problems with moisture
- Minimum Weigh Bar capacity 75,000lb each
- Lightning protection-standard
- Dedicated conduit runs to protect cabling between sensor and junction
- Five (5) Year on-site warranty on parts, labour and manufacturing defects
- Maintenance and care manuals in both official languages
- One (1) day of on-site training for up to four (4) operators

Additional Considerations

- Current Scale Display is Avery Weigh-Tronix AVS-7 1310 Indicator. Replacement at Shearwater must be compatible with current Bridgmont scale located there that is not being replaced.
- Displays are located beside the scales and are exposed to the elements and sea air. Unit must therefore be weather resistant and withstand fluctuations in temperature
- Displays Kiosks are stand alone and there is no requirement for data/import requirements. System is weigh in/weigh out system operated by the drivers via by a swipe card.
- Existing traffic lights may be re-used if they are compatible with the replacement scale and kiosk system.
- There is no requirement for an intercom or communication feature.
- Display Kiosk must have print capabilities for capturing empty/loaded weights. Driver swipe cards are used to capture pre and post load weights.

- Departmental Engineers have inspected confirmed visible footings were in good condition and can be re-used. Uninspected areas may be in need of repair but should not require replacement.
- Any required concrete repairs will fall to DND.
- Drawings for the initial install are unavailable.

SACC Manual Clause B3000T (2006-06-16) Equivalent Products

1. Products that are equivalent in form, fit, function and quality to the item(s) specified in the bid solicitation will be considered where the Bidder:
 - a. designates the brand name, model and/or part number of the substitute product;
 - b. states that the substitute product is fully interchangeable with the item specified;
 - c. provides complete specifications and descriptive literature for each substitute product;
 - d. provides compliance statements that include technical specifics showing the substitute product meets all mandatory performance criteria that are specified in the bid solicitation; and
 - e. clearly identifies those areas in the specifications and descriptive literature that support the substitute product's compliance with any mandatory performance criteria.
2. Products offered as equivalent in form, fit, function and quality will not be considered if:
 - a. the bid fails to provide all the information requested to allow the Contracting Authority to fully evaluate the equivalency of each substitute product; or
 - b. the substitute product fails to meet or exceed the mandatory performance criteria specified in the bid solicitation for that item.
3. In conducting its evaluation of the bids, Canada may, but will have no obligation to, request bidders offering a substitute product to demonstrate, at the sole cost of bidders, that the substitute product is equivalent to the item specified in the bid solicitation.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
