Questions & Answers #1

- Q1.** “We have looked at the dimensions and believe you can't be CSA compliant with the dimensions given, and the items requested. Is there a way to 'enlarge' the area?”
- A1.** Please see Addendum #2 for updates to the Statement of Work as DFATD is not able to enlarge the area. The balance of design and its remaining items will be CSA compliant.
- Q2.** “For shipping to Beijing, were we supposed to quote on this as well?”
- A2.** The shipping location is identified in the RFP and to be included in the submitted price. Alternatively, if a proponent/bidder manufactures in China, DFATD will accept delivery directly to the site. No split/partial shipment will be accepted. Regardless of option chosen, the Bidder is responsible for all shipping costs to their chosen delivery destination.
- Q3.** “Contractors in Beijing, should we state that we have a local team there, does that help? Or the Government will tender this RFP out as well?”
- A3.** As stipulated in the RFP, a separate installation package will be issued for the use by a local contractor. Local contractor presence does not influence the selection process as installation will be separate.
- Q4.** “Can you confirm, what is the Government’s expectation on timing of receipt in Ottawa, when to arrive in Beijing, and when to have it fully operational/in use?”
- A4.** The Bidder is expected to start fabrication upon contract award and deliver once playground equipment is completed.
- Q5.** “We would design and procure here, the tech people would do virtual commission here, but I would go onsite to Beijing? Did I read that I could take my immediate family with me too for this time period?”
- A5.** Please view the section titled “TASKS” of Appendix “A” – Statement of Work for information on individuals to be on-site; please note DFATD will accept a local 3rd party contractor to perform on-site support and/or certification if required.

The section titled “BACKGROUND” of Appendix “A” – Statement of Work is included for the sole purpose of providing context for this project. Contractors on this project are not considered as “Canadians assigned to the Beijing mission”.
