Annex A: Statement of Work - 6. Deliverables and Schedule (page 43) contains a table which lists deliverables. Item 6.4 appears to be missing from this list. Can the Contracting Authority confirm whether a deliverable is missing from the schedule or if this is a typographical error?

Question 3

Annex A: Statement of Work - 7 Public Safety Canada support (pg 45) states that PS will endeavour to provide the Contractor with "required PS equipment (e.g., a laptop, a tablet) to administer the survey, including approved software"

Does PS have required equipment, including approved platforms, to administer the telephone component of the survey and will PS provide the Contractor with this equipment?

Answer 3

Any equipment required to undertake the survey, whether online or via other communication methods, will be provided by PS.

Question 4

There are two faculty members at our university who are interested in submitting their own independent project for this call. There may be other faculty members as well.

Can you clarify whether this RFP is limited to one application per institution?

If it is not limited to one person, does the faculty members' name go under "Central Point of Contact" on the bottom of page 2?

Answer 4

As per the standard instructions 2003 article 4, the definition of a Bidder is as follows: "Bidder" means the person or entity (or, in the case of a joint venture, the persons or entities) submitting a bid to perform a contract for goods, services or both. It does not include the parent, subsidiaries or other affiliates of the Bidder, or its subcontractors.

Faculty members may submit a proposal individually as per the above definition. Each proposal will be treated and evaluated individually. They can indicate the individuals name under Central Point of Contact.
