1 <u>Instructions, clarification, and evaluation procedures</u>

1.1 Requirement

Award up to two contracts per region to vendors (Pacific – West – Central – East and Atlantic Canada) with specialists who would perform Office Ergonomic Assessments and follow-ups virtually and/or in person in NRC locations and/or employee's house. NRC may require additional professional services related to the findings report. Vendors may bid on 1 or all 5 regions.

1.2 Evaluation procedure

The proposal will be evaluated and scored in accordance with specific evaluation criteria as detailed herein. It is imperative that these criteria be addressed in sufficient depth in the proposal to fully describe the Bidder's response.

1.2.1 Step 1: Evaluation against Corporate and Technical Mandatory Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated to determine if all mandatory requirements detailed in this Annex "Mandatory Criteria" have been met. Only those proposals meeting ALL mandatory requirements will then be evaluated in accordance with Step 2.

1.2.2 Step 2: Evaluation against Point-Rated Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated and scored in accordance with point-rated evaluation criteria detailed in this Annex "Point Rated Criteria". Proposals that do not achieve a minimum average score of 50% will be considered non-compliant and will receive no further consideration. Evaluators' scores will be averaged.

1.2.3 Step 3: Method/Basis of Selection

The method of selection will be highest combined Technical Rating (70%) and Price (30%). To be declared responsive a proposal must:

- a) Comply with all the requirements of the bid solicitation and;
- b) Meet all the mandatory technical evaluation criteria and;

c) Obtain the required minimum average score of 50% of the points for the technical evaluation criteria which are subject to point rating. Bids not meeting all 3 steps will be declared non-responsive.

1.2.4 Step 4: Issuance of a Contract

The Compliant Bidder(s) with highest combined Technical Rating (70%) and Price (30%) will be recommended for issuance of a Contract.

1.3 Customer Reference Contact Information

The Bidder must provide two separate (2) customer references who can speak to two different projects and must each confirm, if requested by Canada the facts identified in the Bidder's bid. For each customer reference, the Bidder must, at a minimum, provide the name, the telephone number and e-mail address for a contact person. Bidders are also requested to include the title of the contact person. If there is a conflict between the information provided by the customer reference and the bid, the information provided by the customer reference will be evaluated instead of the information in the bid. If the named individual is unavailable when required during the evaluation period, the Bidder may provide the name and contact information of an alternate contact from the same customer.

1.4 Corporate Profile

The Bidder is requested to provide a corporate profile, which should include an overview of the Bidder and any subcontractors, and/or authorized agents of the Bidder that would be involved in the performance of the Work on the Bidder's behalf. The Bidder is requested to provide a brief description of its size, corporate structure, years in business, business activities, major customers, number of employees and their geographic presence. This information is requested for information purposes only and will not be evaluated.
