This amendment is raised to revise the bid closing date and to distribute questions and answers.

# 1. Bid Closing Date

The closing date for solicitation 5P468-21-0158/B is extended from 02 March 2022 until 07 March 2022 at 14:00 Eastern Daylight Time (EST).

## 2. Questions and Answers

- Q6. Is the Museum self-sufficient with their own water reserve in case of fire?
- A6. The water reserve consists of two (2) tanks with a combined capacity of 25,000 gallons. However, the tanks are fed by rainwater and maintaining the proper water level in the tanks has become precarious, given the low rainfall. In addition, the present work will require the shutdown of the fire pumps for a few weeks. The municipality's fire department has the necessary equipment and partnerships to ensure the protection of the building during the work related to the water source. It will be able to have additional trucks for water supply and additional assistance in case of need from nearby fire stations. It will draw up an intervention plan for this period.
- Q7. Is the structure of the building made of steel, concrete or wood? Can there be presence of wood within the structure?
- A7. The existing structure is made of concrete and steel, and there is no wood in the structure. The only exceptions are the outdoor belvedere and the entrance terrace (exterior), which have a wooden structure. However, there are no interventions in those areas in this project.
