A. Questions & Answers

Q1. Are you able to provide the number of fit testing requests per region for the past 5 years or year?

A1. This is a first time program for the CRA so we do not have any historical information to provide. However, the initial projected number of fit tests required is approximately 10 fit tests for each location identified in Annex A: Statement of Work, Attachment 3: List of CRA locations, to start with.

Q2. Are you able to provide the names of the winning suppliers for the previous Respiratory Protective Services RFP?

A2. As mentioned above, this is a first time program, so there have not been any RFPs for these goods and services in the past.

Q3. Some of the suppliers whom provide fit testing services do not supply the equipment. Therefore, are you able to separate the RFP requirements for fit testing and supplying equipment?

A3. At this stage in the process, the CRA feels confident that there are companies that can provide both the respirators and the fit test and training required to support proper use of the respirators. This RFP also provides the option for companies to create a joint venture so that they may work with another company to provide a bid that covers both sides of this requirement. Based on the above, the CRA will keep the RFP as is at this time.
