## B. The following question has been received, and DFATD hereby answers as follows:

#### **Question 1:**

After reviewing the RFP, we have a question about the 15km distance of our proposed facility to 125 Sussex:

Is this distance in a straight line (as the crow flies) or is it by land transport (driveable 15km)?

#### **Answer 1:**

The training location must be within 15 kilometers <u>of driveable distance</u> from 125 Sussex Drive, Ottawa, Ontario K1A 0G2. Criterion M5 has been added below to make this requirement clearer.
